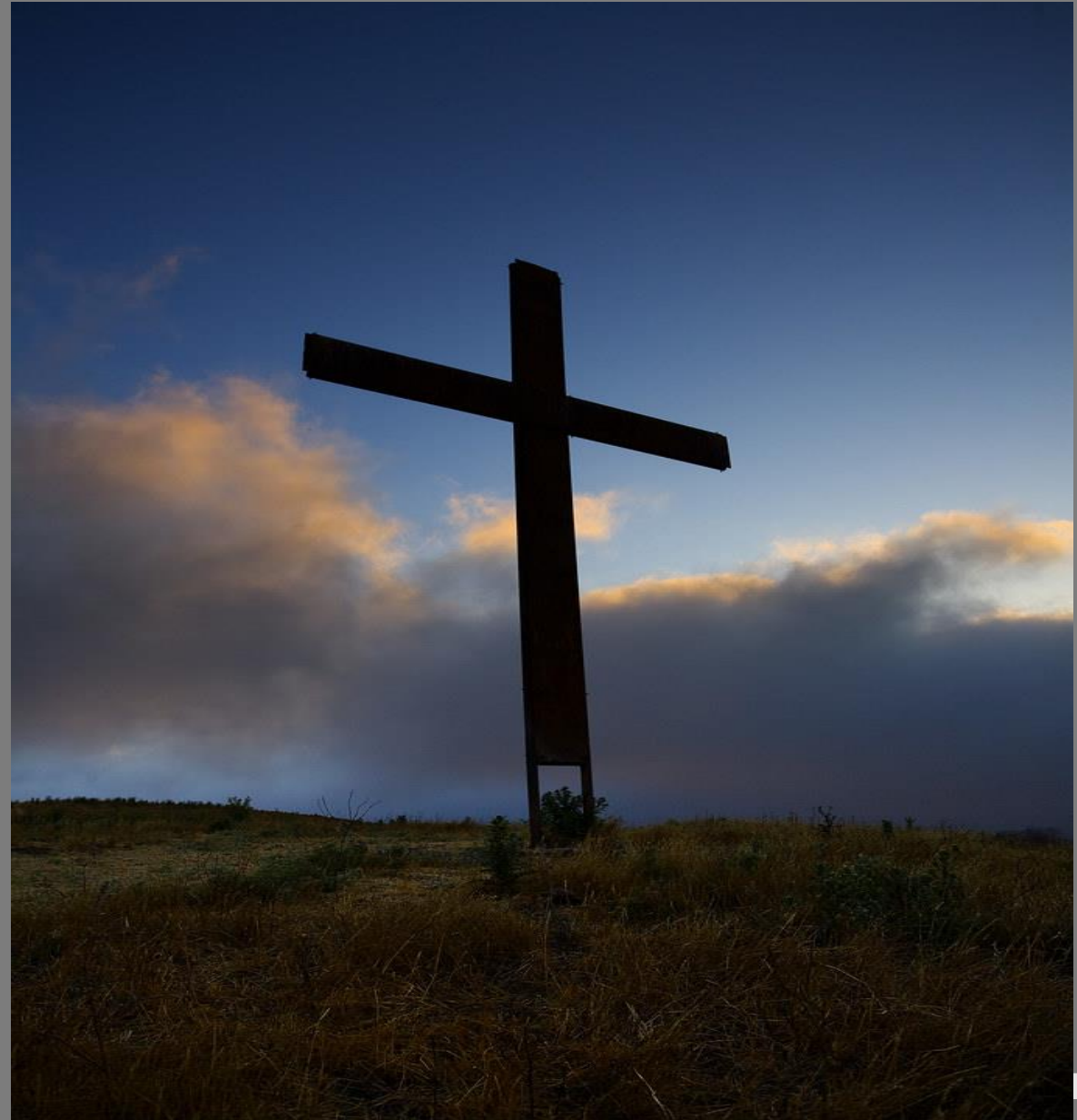
Class Norms

Scripture

Exodus 20:7-11

7 Do not misuse the name of the LORD your God, because the LORD will not leave anyone unpunished who misuses his name. 8 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy: 9 You are to labor six days and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. You must not do any work—you, your son or daughter, your male or female servant, your livestock, or the resident alien who is within your city gates. 11 For the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and everything in them in six days; then he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and declared it holy.

Honor God

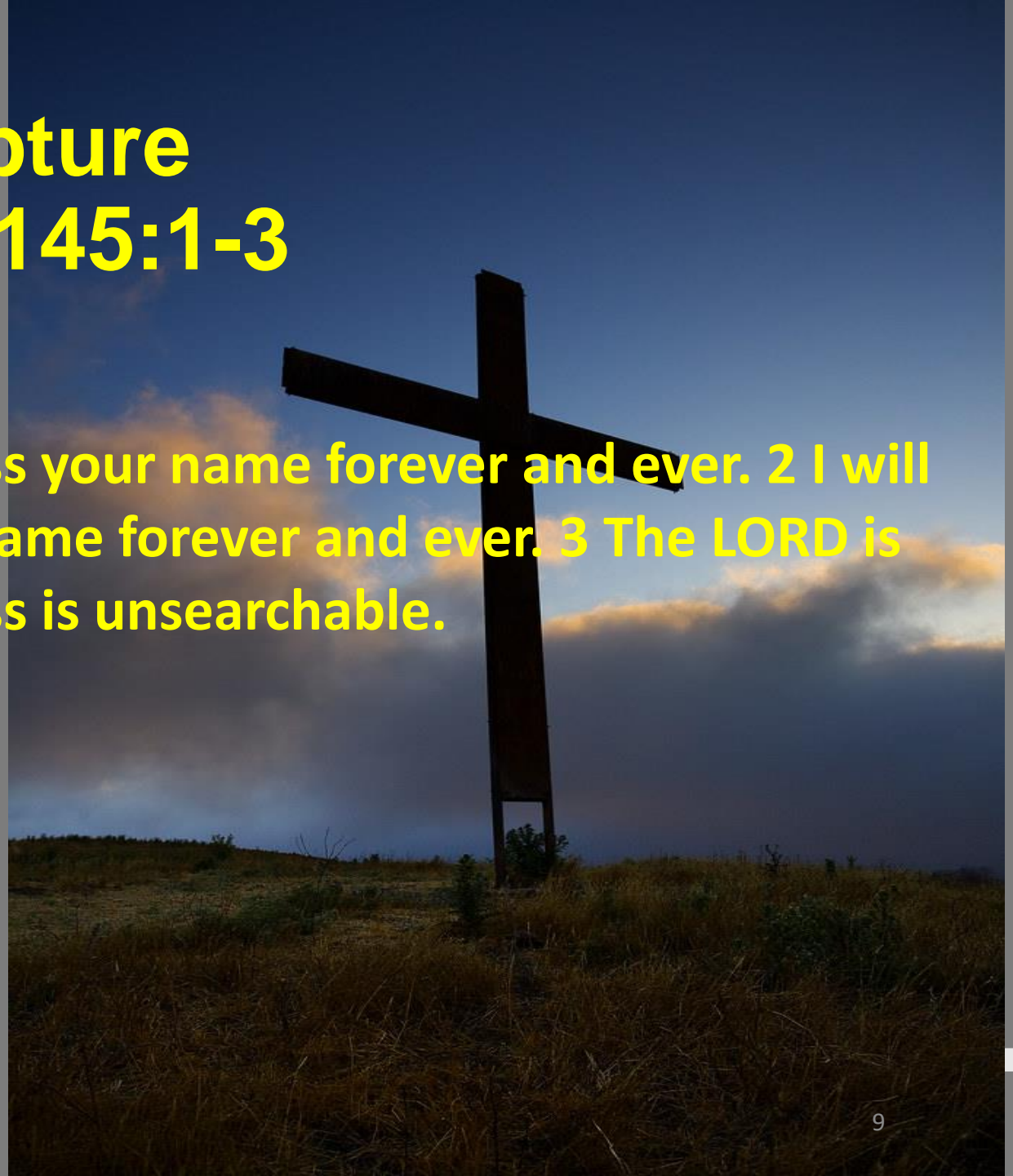
Exodus 20:7-11

- A person's name is a symbol or representation of that person.
- God's name, Yahweh, is more than just a title.
- Sabbath was "holy," that is, set apart for God (Exodus 16:23; see also vv. 29-30)

Psalm 145:1-3

1 I exalt you, my God the King, and bless your name forever and ever. 2 I will bless you every day; I will praise your name forever and ever. 3 The LORD is great and is highly praised; his greatness is unsearchable.

Honor God

Psalm 145:1-3

- David praised God and declared he would bless God every day. Not just on the good days. Not just on the days when he felt like dancing and singing in the streets. Not just on the victory days. No, David penned his heart's desire to worship God every single day.
 - God knows the state of each of our souls. He desires to shape and sharpen us during the tough times. He has a purpose for the pain, and He seeks to make us increasingly more like Jesus.
 - Worship Him in spite of the reality of where you are on a given day. Worship Him every day.

Scripture

Psalm 145:4-7

4 One generation will declare your works to the next and will proclaim your mighty acts. 5 I will speak of your splendor and glorious majesty and your wondrous works. 6 They will proclaim the power of your awe-inspiring acts, and I will declare your greatness. 7 They will give a testimony of your great goodness and will joyfully sing of your righteousness.

Place God First

Psalm 145:4-7

- Yes, we sometimes wrap our vanity into conveniently masked terms such as legacy and reputation. But any time we shift the focus from God and place it on ourselves, we've failed to honor Him through our testimony and actions. We've failed to put Him first.

- **Write it down.** Journaling is a great way of identifying the pressing thoughts on your heart and mind. Take a moment each day this week to let your own words express how much you honor and worship God.
- **Consider what you share.** Consider how you use social media and social interactions to point other people to God. Look for opportunities to take the focus off yourself and direct it to Him.
- **Share your story.** Seek to share with someone else your personal experience of God and His power in your life. Honor Him with your testimony.
